3. Quotation/s must include all kinds of taxes for the item(s)/services listed hereunder, including delivery charges;
4. Price quotation/s submitted shall be valid for a period of one hundred twenty (120) calendar days from the deadline of submission and receipt of quotation;
5. Terms of payment: Monthly, upon issuance of billing statement
6. Quotation/s shall be submitted to the Procurement Unit, 2nd Floor BAR Annex Building, DA-BAR, Elliptical Road cor. Visayas Ave., Diliman, Quezon City;
7. Only sealed canvasses shall be considered by the BAC.
8. Bidders shall reflect on the envelope the RFQ No. and/or the PR No., the BAC shall not be responsible on the pre-emptive/premature opening of the quotation;
9. Bid envelopes that are not properly sealed and marked, as required in the Request for Quotation (RFQ), shall not be rejected, but the Bidder or its duly authorized representative shall acknowledge such condition of the bid as submitted. The BAC or the Procuring Entity shall assume no responsibility for the misplacement of the contents of the improperly sealed or marked bid, or for its premature opening.
10. Awarding shall be done as one (1) LOT;
11. Delivery and Installation Period: Ten (10) Calendar Days upon receipt of the Notice to Proceed (NTP).
12. To guarantee the faithful performance by the winning bidder of its obligations under the contract, it shall post a performance security within a maximum period of ten (10) calendar days from the receipt of the Notice of Award from the Procuring Entity and in no case later than the signing of the contract;
